# **Open Science**

#### **Definition** (MoU, HR-OOZ Initiative):

"A modern, collaborative and publicly open transparent research process aimed at the rapid use of results in the economy and society in general; such a process relies on digital tools and services, i.e. the possibilities of information and communication technology, and is recognizable by the openness and FAIR principles in accessing research data."




Figure 1 Openness in different stages of research process. Reference: Open Science and Research, 2014.























# Croatian Open Science Cloud

- Use and connect the existing national elements of open science for the development of HR-OOZ and connect them with the European / international network
- Ensure that there is a national plan for the development of research **infrastructure** (including e-infrastructure)
- Develop and maintain national cooperation and bring together all relevant stakeholders:
  - horizontal: joint projects for the development of new infrastructures, services and resources
  - vertical: joint projects for building data standards, catalog of services, joint application for large (scientific) and challenging projects
- Ensure funding and sustainability of research infrastructures (including einfrastructure)

Drafting the proposal of the National Plan for Open Science and proposal of the law governing the scientific activity in the part related to the open science

























  - President (Ivan Marić, SRCE) and two vice-presidents (Dr. David M. Smith, IRB & Assoc. Prof. Dr. Irena K. Martinović, HRZZ) were elected

TF for drafting the proposal of the national plan and policies for open science

#### **Tasks**

- → Proposal of national open science plan
- → Proposal for provisions related to open science for the new law governing scientific activities
- → Open science policy template for the science and higher education institutions which can be used or adopted by institution needs

#### Activities

- → Mapping OS activities, initiatives, projects, stakeholders and services in Croatia
- → Gathering information about national plans and laws about OS
- → Developing proposal of national plan for OS
- → Tracking adoption of OS policies

#### **Tasks**

- Defining sustainable organizational and management structure
- → Defining principles and criteria for on boarding services and recourses into HR-OOZ
- → Establishing catalogue of HR-OOZ services and resources

- → Defining elements of catalogue for HR-OOZ services and resources
- → Developing Terms of Use template for services and resources in HR-OOZ


































#### **HR-OOZ Initiative Task Forces - Timeline**
